

1. No weapons allowed

9. Keep children and pets in your line of sight at all times and please clean up after your pets
10. Quiet time begins at 11:00 p.m.
11. Check-out is at 10:00 a.m.
12. Check-in is at 2:00 p.m.

The Coal Creek OHV Trail System is accessible from all sites without travel on public roads.

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Sites Available The rates below do not include state, local or hotel tax. Rates are subject to change.

RV Sites (39)

\$38 per night, 2 people

Full Hookups: 30, 50 amps, 110

Each additional person over 15 yrs old, \$3 per night, per person

Weekly RV rate (minimum of 7 days) \$250 + tax* (*Excludes Holidays or Events)

The RV Sites include water, sewage, electricity, concrete patios, picnic tables, fire rings and bath house.

Cabins (10)

Sleeps 4, bedding not provided, \$100 per night

Weekly Cabin rate (min. 7 days) \$630 + tax* (*Excludes Holidays or Events)

Cabins are furnished with 2 bunk beds, kitchenette, bathroom with shower and fire rings.

Primitive Camping (25)

\$16 per night, 2 people

Each additional person over 15 yrs old, \$3 per night, per person

Weekly Primitive Camping rate (minimum of 7 days) \$100 + tax* (*Excludes Holidays or Events)

Primitive Campsites have fire rings and bath house.

Long Term RV Sites

\$540 per month

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Traveling I-75 north from Chattanooga:

Take exit 376A (Hwy 162N) to Oak Ridge. Hwy 162 will merge with Hwy 62 in Solway. Follow Hwy 62 west through Oak Ridge (Hwy 62 is also named Illinois Ave. in Oak Ridge) to the intersection of Hwy 95 (also named Oak Ridge Turnpike). Follow Hwy 62 into Oliver Springs 4.3 miles to a traffic light with a Food City Grocery Store on the right. Continue on Hwy 62 1.2 miles to Windrock Road, just past the Oliver Springs overpass. Turn right on Windrock Road and travel .8 mile to Windrock Park Lane on the right.

Traveling I-40 east from Nashville:

Take Harriman/Rockwood Exit and turn right on Highway 27/61. Follow Hwy. 61 to the 1st traffic light in Oliver Springs. Go 200 yards, turn left onto Windrock Road and travel .8 mile to Windrock Park Lane on the right.

Traveling I-40 west from Asheville:

Take I-40 west (Take the I-640 bypass in Knoxville due to construction and follow the Chattanooga/Nashville signs until you reconnect with I-40 west. www.SmartFIX40.com) Take exit 376A (Highway 162N) to Oak Ridge. Hwy 162 will merge with Hwy 62 in Solway. Follow Hwy 62 west through Oak Ridge (Hwy 62 is also named Illinois Ave. in Oak Ridge) to the intersection of Hwy 95 (also named Oak Ridge Turnpike). Follow Hwy 62 into Oliver Springs 4.3 miles to a traffic light with a Food City Grocery Store on the right. Continue on Hwy 62 1.2 miles to Windrock Road, just past the Oliver Springs overpass. Turn right on Windrock Road and travel .8 mile to Windrock Park Lane on the right.

Traveling I-75 south from Lexington:

Take I-75 south (I-640 West) to I-40 West. Take exit 376A (Highway 162N) to Oak Ridge. Hwy 162 will merge with Hwy 62 in Solway. Follow Hwy 62 west through Oak Ridge (Hwy 62 is also named Illinois Ave. in Oak Ridge) to the intersection of Hwy 95 (also named Oak Ridge Turnpike). Follow Hwy 62 into Oliver Springs 4.3 miles to a traffic light with a Food City Grocery Store on the right. Continue on Hwy 62 1.2 miles to Windrock Road, just past the Oliver Springs overpass. Turn right on Windrock Road and travel .8 mile to Windrock Park Lane on the right.
